A spinal tap was done & they are awaiting the results but the doctors believe she has either Lupus or Devic Disease.

Karen Lewis...was diagnosed with an aggressive form of breast cancer. She went to her oncologist last week for a lumpectomy and the biopsy results showed that her lymph nodes are clear. They are waiting for a call from the dr. to find out whether she is in stage 1 or 2. She will begin chemo next week for 18 weeks and then radiation for 6 weeks following that.

Lucas Appleton...has been diagnosed with an enlarged heart. He goes back to his doctors in Santa Barbara on Feb. 2<sup>nd</sup> and back to UCLA on the 7<sup>th</sup>. Lucas and his family are still waiting for DNA test results in order to confirm diagnosis and explore treatment options.
